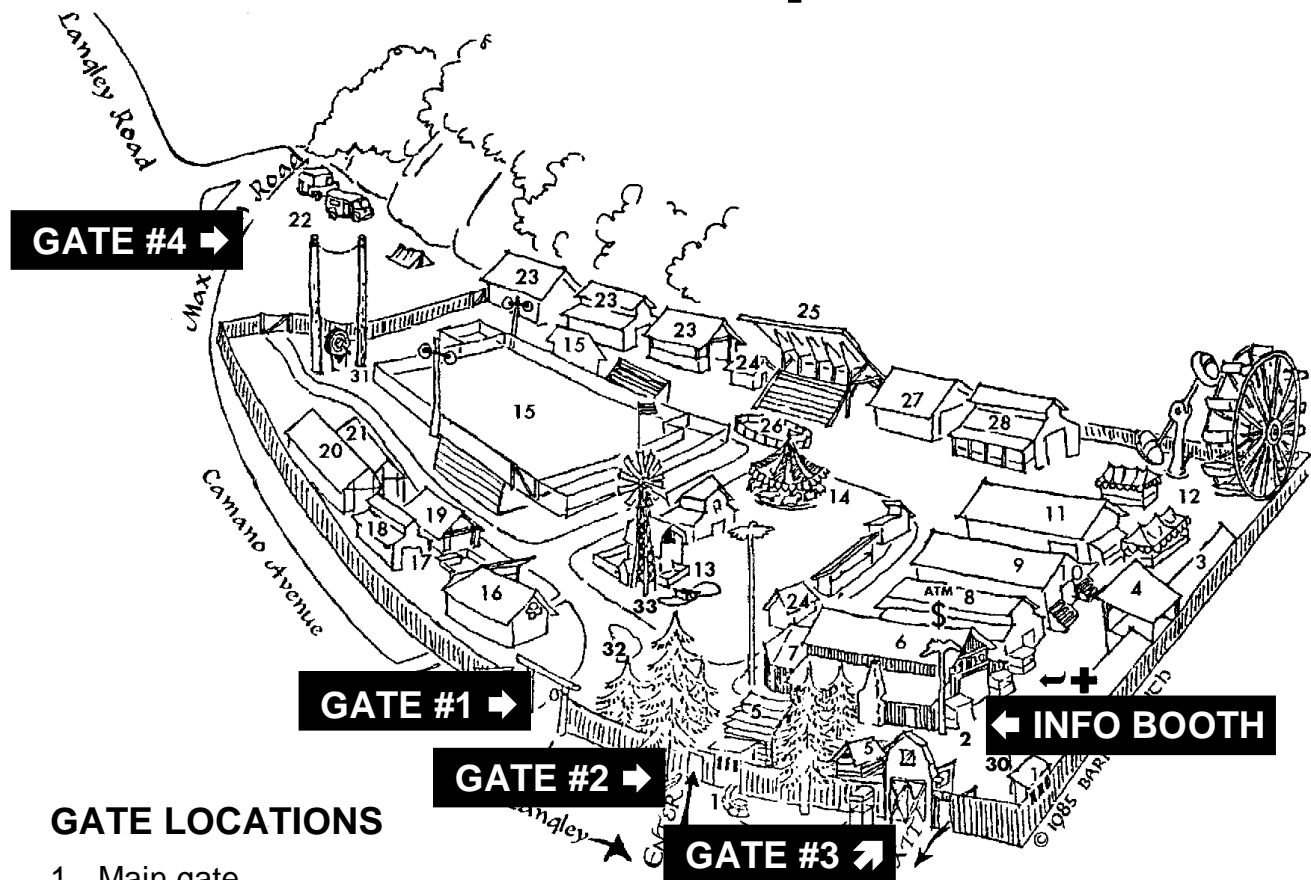




# ISLAND FAIR COUNTY FAIR

## Gate keepers



### GATE LOCATIONS

1. Main gate
2. Ticket booth gate
3. Midway gate
4. Campground gate

### MINIMUM PERSONNEL & HOURS REQUIRED

**GATE #1** One person — 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. (later on Saturday)

**GATE #2** Two-three people — 9 a.m. to 8 p.m.

**GATE #3** Two-three people — 9 a.m. to 8 p.m.

**GATE #4** One person — 7 a.m. to 10 p.m.

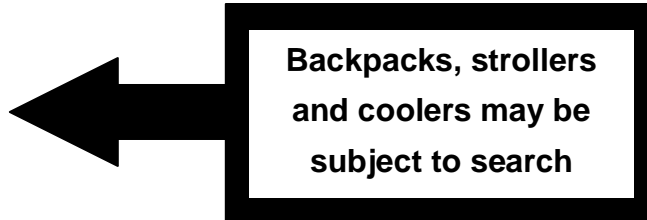
### ENTRY RULES

1. No animals are allowed on the grounds through **ANY** gate except 4-H show animals, accompanied by a 4-H'er with proper identification. The only exceptions to this are:

Saturday morning at the main gate, when the parade enters;  
working service animals.

## **JOB DESCRIPTION**

At each gate, a copy of this year's bonafide wristbands, tickets and passes will be posted. Wristbands must be securely fastened to the wearer's wrist before entry is allowed. The majority of fairgoers enter through Gates #2 and #3. As guests enter,

the TICKET TAKER accepts the ticket from each person entering, verifies it as a valid ticket, and deposits it in the collection box. Be aware of the colors of the tickets presented, and ensure that they match the samples shown on the guide. Pick-ups will be made throughout the day, and bogus tickets will be returned to the gates as a warning of what to watch for.

the HAND STAMPER stamps the inside left wrist with the daily stamp, which allows re-entry to the fair for those guests who purchased a day pass only. **HANDSTAMPING OCCURS ON ENTRY ONLY.** If a guest shows signs of the stamp having been washed away but still slightly visible, the stamp may be reapplied, but no handstamping is allowed on exit.

Vigilance is required to ensure that the hand stamp reads properly, as, for example, "ICF Saturday" rather than the reverse image of "FCI yadrutaS" which occurs when the image is dampened and pressed from one person's wrist to another's.

## **VEHICLE ENTRY**

Vendor vehicles are allowed on the grounds to restock through Gate #1 only, and must be off the grounds by 8:45 each morning. After 8:45 a.m. deliveries must be walked in. No vehicles are allowed on the grounds during the open hours of the fair whatsoever. On Sunday night, vehicles are not allowed through the main gate after the fair closes at 9 p.m. **UNTIL** the departing crowd has thinned out sufficiently for pedestrian safety in the darkness. Gate personnel will be advised by office staff when it is safe for vehicles to enter.

## **PEOPLE WITHOUT TICKETS OR WRISTBANDS**

**THERE IS NO 'WILL CALL' FOR TICKETS.** Various people may show up at the entry gates for admission without tickets, passes or wristbands. The only entry gate to accommodate these people is Gate #1. Anyone trying to enter without a ticket, pass or wristband at other gates must be directed to Gate #1. The gatekeeper at that post will have a daily list of expected judges, stewards or demonstrators who are cleared for entry, as well as a radio to summon help in difficult situations. Personnel at gates #2 and #3 should politely redirect unticketed guests to Gate #1 so as not to impede the flow of traffic through their entry gates.
