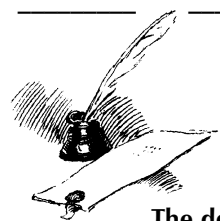

1. Scenic photo
2. People picture

9. Regular film and camera, black/white or color (digitally imaged by scanning, then enhanced or manipulated and printed by exhibitor)
10. Digital capture, black/white or color (photo taken with a digital camera, then enhanced or manipulated and printed by exhibitor)

11. 4-H Photo Album – **Contact the 4-H Office for specific criteria.**
12. Sequence of up to six photographs that tell a story or “how to do it,” complete with a beginning and an ending, a title, and “preferred” captions. This class can be black/white or color, each 3½x5 inches or larger – up to 8x12 or 5x14 inches. Digital photos will be accepted, provided all photos in the entry are from the same type of camera and printed using the same method.
13. Four to six photographs on the same theme, mounted on a board. A title is required; captions, poems or other written words are optional. This class can be black/white or color, each 3½x5 inches or larger – up to 8x12 or 5x14 inches. Digital photos will be accepted, provided all photos in the entry are from the same type of camera and printed using the same method.

1. Beans 5 pods, green (name variety)
2. Beans 5 pods, yellow (name variety)
3. Beets 5 baby, under 1½" diameter
4. Beets 5 table size, 1½-to-3½" diameter
5. Broccoli (one head)
6. Cabbage, one head, leaves on
7. Carrots (5), ½-1½ diameter (trimmed)
8. Cauliflower (one head, leaves on)
9. Chard, 3 stalks, in water
10. Corn, 2 ears, sweet
11. Cucumbers (3) 2½" to 5" long (with stem)
12. Cucumbers (2) slicing, 6" or longer
13. Dill, 3-5 stalks, in water
