

## FAIR & ENTRY-RELATED TIMELINE

**JULY 15** Online pre-entry begins. Go to [www.islandcountyfair.com](http://www.islandcountyfair.com) and click on the Online Entry/Premium Book tab. Please enter only those items you actually plan to bring to the Fair, as “no-show” entries cost the Fair money.

**JULY 20** Requests for 4-H wristbands due to the 4-H Office, along with one check per club.  
Judge payment request forms due to the 4-H Office from superintendents.

**AUGUST 1** Animal classes must be pre-entered online before 5 p.m.  
Campground request forms due to the Fair Office, along with one check per club for all reservations.

**AUGUST 16  
NOON** Deadline for entry of all non-animal-related 4-H exhibits, contests and/or premium events in Departments 101-105.  
Club wristband/ticket packets available for pick-up in the 4-H Building.

**AUGUST 17** 5 p.m. Horse vet check and stall assignment  
6:00 All camping units must be in place  
8:00 Swine vet check and placement

**AUGUST 18** 8 a.m. Sheep vet check and placement  
9:00 Poultry vet check and cage placement  
10:00 Cavy vet check and placement  
Goat vet check and placement  
10:30 Rabbit vet check and pen assignment  
Noon Vet check and placement: Cat, Cattle, Dog, Alpaca/Llama
